The past year has been a roller-coaster ride on the crime front in Tokai. Some months lower than in previous years, however other months crime running rampant. The biggest contributor has been the alarming increase in residential burglaries and attempted residential burglaries. These increased year on year by 45% and 67% respectively. This is of extreme concern.

The TNCW want to focus on getting the Zone Mangers and street co-ordinators up and running in Tokai. This to initiate enthusiasm amongst neighbours and TNCW Members to look after each other that are close to you.

We are looking for members to volunteer to take up the role of a Zone Manager for your area and that of a Street coordinator for your street. 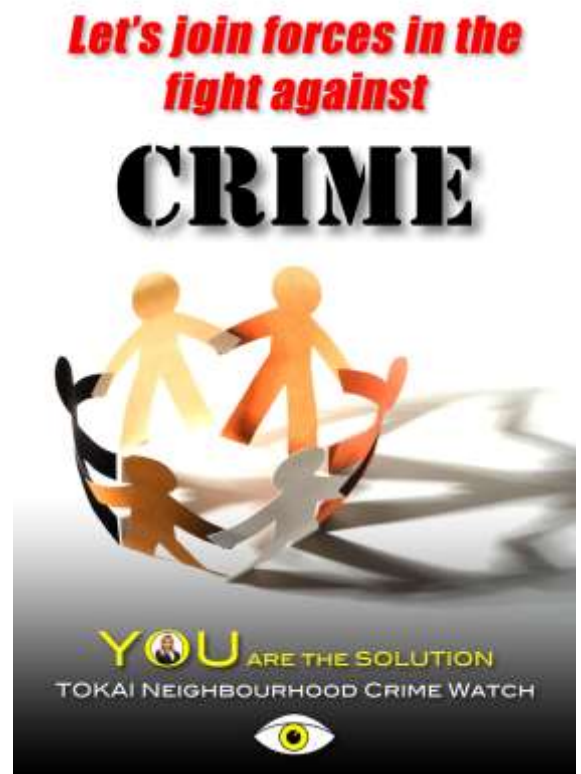
We need more patrollers in Tokai!!

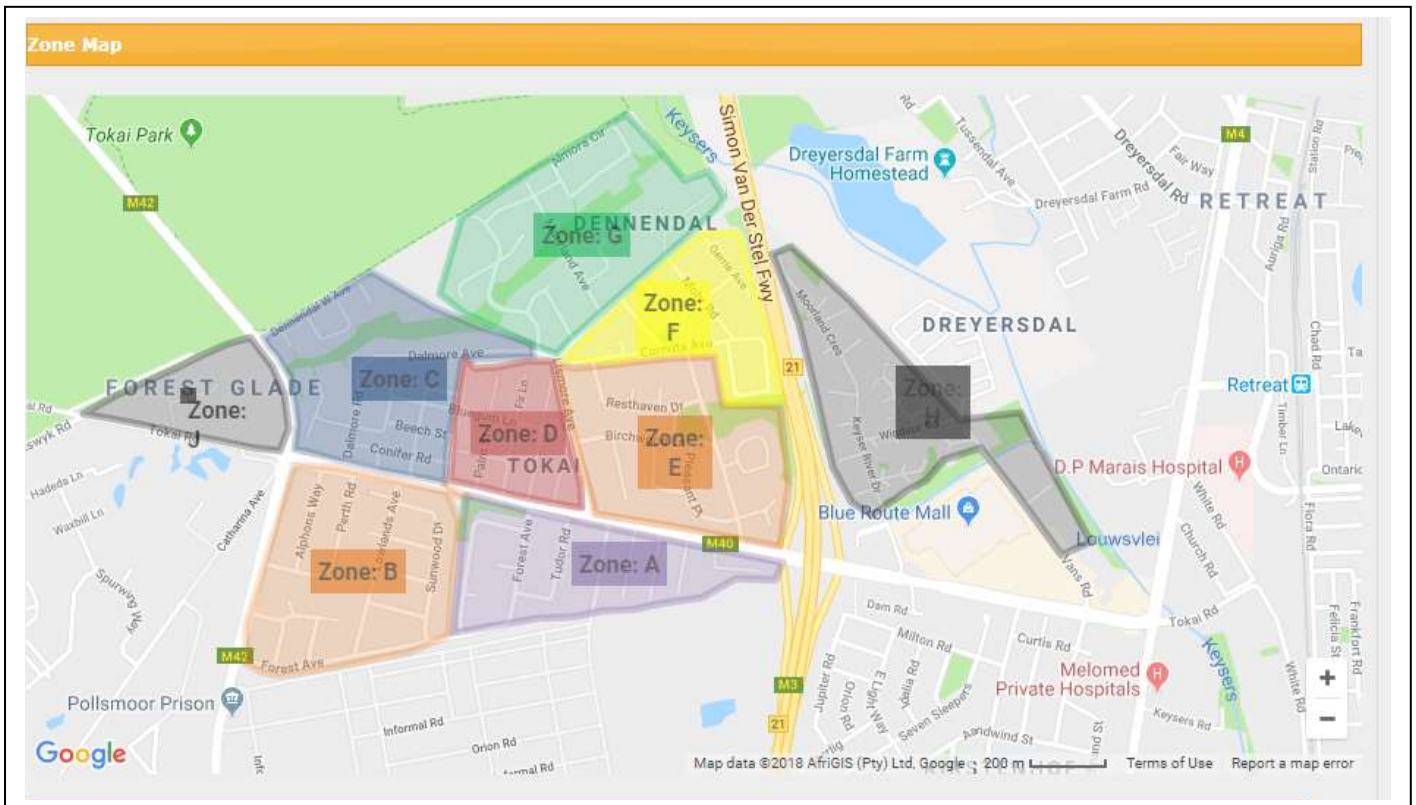
